Elements of a myth -

- 1. Supernatural forces exist myths involve a god or supernatural power
- 2. Interprets or explain natural events such as an earthquake
- 3. Details human qualities or flaws such as the weakness of too much pride
- 4. Expresses a culture's view of the universe —myths commonly would attempt to explain that which was otherwise; unexplainable.
- 5. Other common elements used include a metamorphosis, monsters, invisibility, trials and tests, trickery, and god's interference

Elements of Tall Tales -

- 1. Main character accomplishes great feats superhuman
- 2. Main character is helped by a powerful object or animal
- 3. The author uses exaggeration
- 4. The story explains how things began or solves a problem
- 5. Hero has a colorful way of speaking.
- 6. Famous people may show up in the tale.
- 7. The hero does not like process.
