

## GREEK MYTHOLOGY INDEPENDENT PROJECTS

You will be given several choices of possible projects related to our study of Greek mythology. You will select one project (task) to complete. Your grade will weigh heavily on the depth of your research, creativity, and the time and effort you exert in completing the task.

Deadline for the independent study projects - October 13th.

The assignments have project sheets (located in the classroom as well as online). Use the project sheets for further instructions in completing your task.

Each project also has a specific rubric that I will use in order to evaluate this assignment. Be sure to follow the rubric as you complete your task.

Evaluation - Your project will be graded on the following:

1. Your ability to follow the specific directions.
2. Neatness and legibility – your projects should not only be free of mistakes but also be very pleasing to the eye. Be sure that all writing is legible.
3. Creativity – most of these projects allow for you to be creative and use a good deal of imagination.
4. **Depth of research** – many of the projects will require you to research the subject in more detail and to use that information to feature in your project.
5. **Proper citation** of your research.
6. Spelling and punctuation – since this is for a grade, you must be careful to spell all words correctly and write complete sentences.
7. Meeting your deadline.
8. For those working in a group: your ability to work effectively with others.

*\* These same projects will be orally presented in the social studies class with Mrs. Davis. You will receive a separate grade in social studies using this same project as the basis for the presentation. We will keep your materials at school until your social studies presentation is completed as well.*
