

RL .7 - Standard Two : Analyze literary text development

a. Determine a theme of a text and analyze its development over the course of the text.

b. Incorporate the development of a theme and other story details into an objective summary of the text.

1. Determine (verb) conclude; decide
2. Theme (noun) main idea in the text; the universal concept (love, revenge, family, etc.); may be stated directly or implied.
3. Development (noun) a process of growth or more advanced; more insight or understanding
4. Course of the text (noun) over the entire passage of words; article; story
5. Incorporate (verb) to include; take in, acknowledge
6. Objective (noun) no personal feelings stated; without judgement; impartial
7. Summary (noun) a brief statement or account of just the main points or facts usually chronologically
