

RL.7 - Standard Four: Determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text, including figurative connotative meanings; analyze the impact of specific language choices, such as sensory words or phrases, on meaning and tone, including rhymes and other repetitions of sounds (e.g., alliteration) on a specific verse or stanza of a poem or section of a story or drama

1. Meaning – (noun) what the words signify or intend; communicate
2. Figurative – (adjective) when writing is not literal; using figures of speech; metaphorical
3. Connotative – (adjective) a secondary meaning in addition to the primary meaning; feelings and emotions you may bring to the word or phrase
4. Impact – (noun) influence; how one item can have an effect on another
