

RL.7 - Standard Five: Analyze how a drama's or poem **form or structure** (e.g., soliloquy, sonnet) **contributes** to its meaning.

1. Form/structure – (noun) form and/or structure refers to the manner in which the passage was designed and written; the recipe used to place the parts of the passage together.
Form/structure can be exact as in a sonnet or they can be for a sound effect such as rhyme. Poetry and drama are two forms of literature which follow unique structural patterns.
2. Contributes - (verb) assists, helps to achieve
