

RL.7 - Standard Seven - **Compare and contrast** a written story, drama, or poem to its audio, filmed, staged, or multimedia version, analyzing the effects of **techniques** unique to each **medium** (e.g., lighting, sound, color, or camera focus and angles in a film).

1. Compare and contrast – (verbs) Examine in order to note likenesses and differences between two or more things
2. Techniques – (noun) an effect unique to each medium such as lighting, sound, color, camera angles and focus, etc.
3. Medium – (noun) type of literature; audio, film, stage, or multimedia version
