

## Attention Future Movie Directors

You have been hired to cast **ONE** of the three main characters for a movie production of “The Highwayman.” Your job will be to identify an actor/actress to play the part you have been assigned.

Using text evidence from the poem, carefully cast your characters. **DO NOT** use actors/actresses who have already played these parts in previous movie versions. Remember to use text evidence to support your selections.

Place your data in a Google Slides show. Follow the directions below to complete your task.

- Page One: Type your name, date, period, and assignment.
- Pages Two - Five: Identify the character that you have been assigned – Try to determine the character’s age, occupation, and description. Cite text evidence from the poem which provides character descriptions/traits or inferences that will help you determine an actor/actress to play this part. You may have to infer, but look for clues to help support your inferences.
  - To cite your evidence, state the poem’s: Part, Stanza, and Line number.
- Page Six: Place an updated image of the actor/actress you have chosen to play this part in your movie. You will need to research the actor/actress and determine their current age. Your actor must be currently alive. Identify key characteristics of the actor/actress which assisted you into making this choice such as hair color, height, weight, built, etc.
  - Explain what it is about this actor/actress that helped you to decide that this is indeed the best person for the part.
  - Reference other works the actor/actress has played that may have also influenced your decision.

Spelling, punctuation, and overall sentence structure will definitely affect your score. Your ***creativity in the design of your pages will influence your overall grade***. See the rubric for more details.
