

Mrs. Johnson's Warrior Time Guidelines

Objectives

Students are expected to

- use time wisely by completing homework, reading AR material, or preparing for tests/quizzes/exams
- receive extra assistance from a teacher
- conference with teacher regarding current grade status
- have an opportunity to use the library

Class Rules

- Bring all necessary materials to class.
- Be in your assigned seat and ready for attendance when the bell rings.
- All students who leave the room *for any reason* must complete the sign-out chart and take the pass. It is important that I know where you are at all times. Students who habitually misuse the pass system may lose this privilege and will no longer be permitted to leave the room.
- Students must have an AR book with them. If a student is struggling to meet his or her AR points, then he/she will be required to read during 5A. Students may receive a lunch detention if AR points are not met within a timely fashion and the student is not using Warrior Time for reading.
- **Students may only leave the room once** during the period so they must choose wisely when asking to leave (unless requested by a teacher). I only allow one student at-a-time to use the pass, so be quick so others may use the pass.
- Electronic devices are permitted for use only to complete assignments and not for playing games or just browsing. Students are not permitted to use their phones and should not bring them to class. Students who misuse this policy will **not** be permitted to use their electronic device(s).
- Students who do not use their Warrior Time wisely may have a lunch detention assigned.
- It is important for Warrior Time to be a quiet time for study. Students who violate this rule will receive a lunch detention.
- Be respectful and courteous of others and their property.
