

Mrs. Johnson's Warrior Time Guidelines

Objectives:

Students are expected to:

- use time wisely by completing homework, reading AR material, or preparing for tests/quizzes/exams
- receive extra assistance from a teacher
- conference with teacher regarding current grade status

Class Rules:

- Bring all necessary materials to class. IF a student must return to his/her locker for materials, **he or she will receive a tardy.**
- Be in your assigned seat and ready for attendance when the bell rings.
- Students who are requesting to use the restroom should do so within the first 5 minutes of the period or the last 10 minutes of class.
- All students who leave the room *for any reason* must complete the sign-out chart. It is important that I know where you are at all times.
- Students must have an AR book with them. If a student is struggling to meet his or her AR points, then he/she will be required to read during 5A. Students may receive a lunch detention if AR points are not met within a timely fashion and the student is not using Warrior Time for reading.
- **Students may only leave the room once** during the period so they must choose wisely when asking to leave (unless requested by a teacher).
- Electronic devices are not permitted unless the student has asked to use the device in an effort to complete an assignment. Students who violate this rule will have their device taken and submitted to the office for the student to pick up at the end of the day.
- Students who do not use their Warrior Time wisely may have a lunch detention assigned.
- It is important for Warrior Time to be a quiet time for study. Students who violate this rule will receive a lunch detention.
- Computer use is restricted for AR unless one asks permission.
- Be respectful and courteous of others and their property.
