## Literary Terms – Fables

- Fables a short fictional tale which uses animals as characters (personified) with the intent of teaching a moral (lesson).
  - A. Aesop the most popular.
  - B. Aesop Fables Characteristics:
    - 1. Teaches a lesson about life.
    - 2. The tale reaches the climatic end with the moral.
    - 3. The purpose of the story is not so much what happened, but what it teaches. The plot does not need to make sense or appear to be real.
    - 4. The characters are few and dialogue, though essential, is minimal.
    - 5. Main characters are usually named in the title and are generally stereotyped, such as the "sly fox" or the "busy ant."
    - 6. Language is concise and gets to the point.
    - 7. The plot is simple with introduction of the characters and setting.
    - 8. Simple dialogue with questions and responses.
