- 5. Styx the river that separates the land of living and that of the dead
- 6. Cerberus three headed dog that guards the underworld
- 7. Elysium Elysian Fields and land of the mortal heroes
- Sisyphus a cruel king of Corinth condemned to push a rock up a hill and will roll back down; he tried to out-smart Zeus.
- 9. Tantalus another cruel king punished to stand in water with fruit above him that would rise up as he reached and water that would disappear when he tried to drink; he had killed his own son
- 10. Gunwales upper edge of the side of a vessel
- 11. Ascended to move up; rise
- 12. Dionysus the god of wine
