

The Titanomachy #5

Titanomachy	War between the Titans and Olympians which lasts 10 years.
Machy	Greek word for war
Titan Forces	Cronus not willing to give up power More Titans than Olympians Atlas was the strongest of all gods – a Titan
Olympian Forces	Zeus builds alliances with certain Titans to gain strength.
Alliance	A formal agreement; relationship built on trust
Hecate	Titaness of the crossroads and magic. Often seen with 3 faces, torches, rope, and/or serpent. Holy and magical.
River Styx and Children:	Nike- victory Zelus – zeal; glory Cratus – authority Bia – Force
Themis	Titaness (law and order) Carries the scales of justice; Clever ones will prevail – divine law. She had the power of prophecy. She became Zeus' first counselor.
Sons of Iapetus	Prometheus (brother of Atlas) and had the gift of prophecy. He knew who would win. Epimetheus (his brother) and he knew that his brother Prometheus was the smart one.
Homes of the Forces: Mt. Othrys	Central Greece and home for the Titan Forces
Mt. Olympus	Northern Greece and home for the Olympians

Gaia assistance to end war	Release and refuel the Cyclopes and Hecatoncheires from Tartarus
Food /Drink	Ambrosia – food of gods Nectar – drink of gods
Gifts lead to victory	The monsters provide gifts for their release: Cyclopes gave Zeus – thunder, lightning, and thunderbolt Poseidon received the trident Hades received the helmet of invisibility Hecatoncheires brute strength overcame the Titans and forced them into submission and locked in Tartarus. They became the guards of Tartarus.
Domains of Power	Having defeated the Titans, the three Olympian sons draw lots. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Poseidon – Sea 2. Hades – Underworld 3. Zeus – Sky
